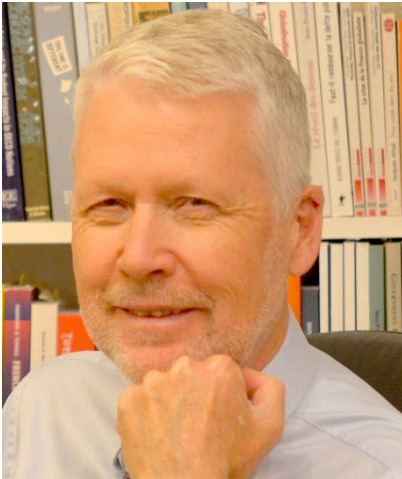


## Marc Robinson: Curriculum Vitae

He has been a keynote speaker at conferences and symposiums held by diverse entities including the European Union, OECD, APEC, NATO and a number of national ministries of finance.

At earlier stages in his career, Marc was a staff economist in the IMF's Fiscal Affairs Department, a senior civil servant and a professor of economics in Australia.
